Getting married in the church

In this day and age, choosing to marry in the church is not obvious, but it is often a conscious and meaningful choice.

What is church marriage?

Church marriage ...

- ... is thanking God for the love that has been allowed to grow and continue to grow,
- ... is to make a commitment with one another, but also a commitment to the church community, friends and family,
- ... is to choose a covenant that is founded in the message of Jesus.

What should we do?

If you want to take the step to a church wedding, you must first apply by contacting pastoor Alexander. This is followed by an initial meeting with the priest where, after a mutual acquaintance, further arrangements are made. The priest will then also start the "marriage file" administratively.

Finally, you will be invited to celebrate Eucharist the weekend before your wedding in the church where you are getting married. In that celebration, your marriage will be announced to the community and you will also be prayed for.
